## Mr. Acre's Test Correction Policy



If you are not happy with your test grade, you may earn half of your points back on your test, up to six (6) percentage points. For example:

Your score is $\frac{57}{75}$, which is a $76 \%$. You do your test corrections CORRECTLY, so your new test grade would be an $82 \% \frac{61.5}{75}$. The net result is that 3.5 points would be added to you score.
(Earning over 100\% is not an option)
Procedure: To be followed for EVERY question you did not earn full points on.

1. Use the Acre Test Correction form. Complete the top of the form.
2. In the box provided, write the question \#, show the correct solution (significant figures and units included), with all of the correct work (even if it is a multiple choice question, write it out)
3. In the WIL box, write a sentence about what you learned from making the correction. We call this a W.I.L or what I learned.

Note: I wrote the test I know what the correct answer is and how to solve for it; I want to know what you learned so you will not make the same mistake again.
4. Staple and turn in, in this order

- Original Quiz or Test
- Completed Test Correction form

5. Be ready to answer a new question from ONE of the problems you got wrong. Resubmit this problem to earn your points back. A word to the wise, an incorrect answer to this problem will result in earning NO points, so please be certain that it is correct. ©)

NOTE:

- If you have been assigned mandatory test corrections due to a poor grade and fail to submit acceptable test corrections in a timely manner your assessment grade will be replaced by a zero. When you submit acceptable test corrections, your grade will be changed accordingly.
- All corrections MUST be correct or no credit will be earned.
- You only have to correct the problems you got wrong.
- Test corrections are due two class periods after the test has been handed back.
- Test corrections are a privilege; if privileges are abused then they are taken away.
